Subject: Field Surveying

Dear Property Owner/Tenant:

The Leon County – City of Tallahassee Blueprint Intergovernmental Agency (Blueprint) will begin conducting field surveys for anticipated roadway improvements to the portion of Bannerman Road from Meridian Road to Quail Commons Drive as part of the Northeast Connector: Bannerman Road project. Project information is available online at www.BannermanRoad.com. This comprehensive data is necessary to assist in the planning and design of the project. In order to collect the necessary information, surveyors may need to enter your property for a short period of time. The surveying will be conducted beginning the week of January 18.

Section 472.029, Florida Statutes (2020), allows surveyors or their duly authorized agents to enter lands for obtaining necessary information upon reasonable notice to the owner. The statute further states that such entry shall not be deemed as trespass. The field survey required on your property will be kept to the minimum required to collect the necessary information.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the Consultant Firms that are authorized by Blueprint to work on the project. It may be necessary for employees of these firms to be on, or near, your property. The authorized Consultants are listed below:
